



CCSC COACHES' GUIDELINES

- 1.** Attend all practices and games. If a conflict arises, insure that a suitable, knowledgeable substitute has been arranged for and properly briefed.
- 2.** Conduct yourself in a professional manner at all times.
- 3.** Ensure good sportsmanship from all members associated with your team.
- 4.** No Yelling at the referees.
- 5.** Set an example to parents and other Coaches by amicably accepting Referees calls even if they do not go your way. If you have a referee issue save it for after the game and address the field manager.
- 6.** No foul language or abusive conduct.
- 7.** Require that players wear their uniforms in a proper and complete fashion. Socks should be pulled up and jerseys tucked in.
- 8.** Provide all players equal playing time:
During league play, each player must play half of the game (50%) if they have satisfied the practice requirements. In addition, the league recommends that playing time be shared equally when game conditions permit, and that players not be utilized in a single position, especially in the younger age groups.
- 9.** Field usage policies:
 - a. All practices and games must be approved by the League.
 - b. Rec. Teams are only allowed to practice one (1) time each week.
 - c. Practice spaces and times are signed up for at the coaches meeting.
If you do not sign up for a time, you need to contact the Youth Sports Director at the Y to see what dates and times are available.
 - d. All teams are responsible for cleaning up after practices and games, and for returning equipment to its proper place.
 - e. All coaches are asked to help in monitoring the activities that take place at the fields, and to assist in keeping our fields clean, safe, and secure.
