Call this number when weather is questionable to find out if games are cancelled. A message will be posted by 8:00 am on game days. Also check this number for practice during the week.

CONDUCT ON THE FIELD

Cheer for and encourage ALL of the kids. Please do not yell instructions from the sidelines. It confuses the players and may not be what the coach is looking for out of the player/play at that time. Let the kids make the decisions during the game; this is an important part of learning to play any sport.

CCSC REQUIREMENTS TO PLAY

Shin Guards – must be worn during all games

Can not be wearing a cast on the body

Can not be wearing jewelry – necklaces, bracelets, earrings (with the exception of newly pierced ears which then must be covered up with band aids)

TIMELINESS

It is important to remember that your child is a part of a team and that those other players need your child to be ready to play by game time. Arrive 15 mins early and always arrive “dressed out”, ready to go on the field.

GAME SHIRTS

Game shirts are provided each season. If you have misplaced your shirt you can check with the Field Supervisor to see if an extra one is available. It will need to be washed and returned to the club. In the event you need to replace a shirt there will be a cost involved and you will need to talk with the Recreation/Field Supervisor.

SOCCER SHAK

The Soccer Shak serves multiple roles for CCSC:

Concession Stand each Saturday.

Shirts will be distributed to the COACHES from the Soccer Shak.

Important Information/Flyers/Updates – will be set out on the concession tables for pick up.

First Aid Kit is located in the Soccer Shak.

INFORMATION BOARD

Important information will be posted on the information board near the stairs from the parking lot. Be sure to check here for information.

PARKING

We have 500+ players signed up this year – and if you account for them and their “support teams” – grandparents, friends – let’s just say parking is an issue. U6 parents should park up near the Y; U8 & up should use the lot near the Soccer Shak. Use common sense when parking – park straight, do not take up more room than you need, do not block the drive itself, pull your vehicle COMPLETELY off the concrete. Do not park where the Orange cones have been set up. If you have the early game, try to park your team, one behind the other instead of across – this allows for a whole column of vehicles to leave at the same time instead of those in the middle getting boxed in.
