



TCL COMMUNICATION

TCL asks that all communication to TCL teams, clubs, members or board members be initiated by the TCL representative for each club. Your Challenge Directors are your TCL representatives.

Types of things to be communicated would include, but not limited to:

- Any issue related to schedules or rescheduling of games.
- Any issue related to referees.
- Any issue related to the TCL website.

TCL wants to ensure that all TCL rep's are in the loop for anything regarding their association/club. If you send something directly to another TCL representative they are not suppose to respond until your club representative has been notified of the issue and initiate the chain of correspondence.

If you send something directly to TCL they will immediately send it to your TCL representative(s) without responding so that your TCL rep can take appropriate action. No matter how minor or major the issue is it will automatically be sent to your TCL representative.

RAINOUTS or GAME RESCHEDULES must first be discussed with your TCL rep who is suppose to communicate directly with the opposing teams TCL rep who will communicate directly with his coaches, ref assignor and field maintenance advisor (if need be).

SCHEDULES

The initial home schedules are set by CCSC Challenge Director. They are set with the consideration of all the challenge teams, the age of the players, the distance of the away team, field availability and referee issues. IF you let your Challenge Director know IN ADVANCE that a particular weekend is an issue many times things can be adjusted around conflicts. IF the schedules have been sent to TCL and posted on the website, THEY ARE SET, no changes will be accepted. It is your responsibility to ask your team early on about any conflicts and to let your Challenge Director know. Your Challenge Director will let you know what the deadlines are for this information each season.

Away games are set by the opposing team and are at their discretion. They take the same issues into consideration when planning their schedules. IF you have an issue with a weekend BEFORE the schedules are posted/being worked on you need to let your Challenge Director know ASAP. There could be the opportunity to petition to not play that day or adjust the time so that both events can take place. Things that will not be taken into consideration are vacations, multiple players playing another sport and can't make the game. These are all items that we have said no to with regards to a reschedule from an opposing club so we will not ask another club to make concessions that we ourselves are not willing to make. IF you have a problem with an away game once they are posted you can discuss it with your Challenge Director. Your Challenge Director has limited power to ask that these games be changed and will do what they can if they can.
